Additional Information

1. All students are required to provide their own horses. If you do not have a horse and wish to enroll, contact the WRA office regarding “horse rental” options. Some horses are available.
2. All Beginner and Advanced applicants must complete the application form in full and submit to the Rodeo Academy. This includes the “short description” at the bottom of the form.
3. **Beginner Classes** are 7 week courses, 1 session per week. Please indicate which sessions you wish to enroll in. All new students must first complete a 7 Week Session of Beginning Horsemanship before they can enroll in any specific event sessions. (You may test out of this class. Please contact the WRA office for more information.)
4. You may enroll for the Beginner Horsemanship class and a later scheduled Beginner Event class now in order to assure your space. Space is Limited.
5. All **Beginner Class** applications must be accompanied by an August 15, 2009 post-dated check for the full amount of the fees. If you are also enrolling for a Beginner Event Class which begins in October or November, that application must be accompanied by an October 15, 2009 post dated check. **No positions will be held without payment.**
6. **Advanced Classes** are for the full semester beginning the week of August 31 and ending in December.
7. **Advanced Classes** - Enrollment in the advanced classes is at the discretion of the enrollment committee. You may be required to complete the Beginner Class before you will be accepted in the Advanced. Advanced class applications must be accompanied by a deposit check in the amount of \$200 post dated for August 15, 2009. **No positions will be held without payment.**
