Additional Information

1. All students are required to provide their own horses. If you do not have a horse and wish to enroll, contact the WRA office regarding "horse rental" options. Some horses are available.
2. All applicants must complete the application form in full and submit to the Rodeo Academy. This includes the "short description" at the bottom of the form.
3. **Beginner Classes** are 7 week courses, 1 session per week. Please see schedule for start dates. (You will be placed in classes according to your current skill level. Please contact the WRA office for more information.)
4. **Intermediate Classes** are once a week for 12 weeks. Please see schedule for start dates.
5. All applications must be accompanied with payment. Payment arrangements are available if necessary. **You will not be able to participate without payment of fees.**
6. **Advanced Classes** are for 15 weeks starting the week of February 6 to the week of May 28, 2012. Advanced classes are held 2 days a week for a total of 30 sessions. **We will not have class the week of February 20 for the family week holiday and the week of April 9 for Easter Break.**
7. **Advanced Classes** - Enrollment in the advanced classes is at the discretion of the enrollment committee. You may be required to complete the Beginner or Intermediate Class before you will be accepted in the Advanced.
8. **All fees must be paid in full at the beginning of the session or students will not be allowed to participate. Please contact the office if you require a payment schedule. Thank you for your cooperation.**
